






MIAMI MOTORCOACH TOUR

	<p>PICKUP TIME: Arrive by 7:15 AM Motorcoach arrives at 7:30 AM and Departs at 8:00 AM</p>

	<p>Bring a face mask if you start coughing, sneezing, etc. uncontrollably during the trip, you will be asked to put on a mask. We will have Covid tests with us on the motorcoach if needed.</p>
	<p>Bring your Driver's License There may be locations we visit that could request to see your ID.</p>
	<p>BUS RULES FOR YOUR SAFETY</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Remain in your seat while the bus is moving. We will stop approximately every 2 to 2.5 hours to give the group an opportunity to use a public restroom. The bus is equipped with a restroom, but it is for emergency use only to limit walking in the aisle while the bus is moving. 2. Do not wear strong scented lotion, perfume or cologne. (someone may have allergies.) 3. Do not bring strong smelling foods or other items onto the bus. (we can't open the windows) 4. If you feel sick for any reason, please alert us immediately. We can get the driver to stop.

TRAVEL TIPS:

- We can't please everyone with the temperature on the bus. Bring a **blanket or a little battery-powered fan.**
- Bring **cash in small bills** for quick stops, tips and souvenir or unique food shops that may only take cash. (please don't bring huge amounts of cash or large bills though)
- Consider bringing a **seat cushion** or **small pillow** for your back and wearing **compression socks** for circulation.
- You may bring an extra **empty tote bag** to bring home souvenirs.
- Wear **comfortable clothes** and **broken-in comfortable shoes!**

REMINDER: THINGS TO DO BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME

- **Fill necessary prescriptions** and make arrangement for any that must be filled while on the trip
- **Call your bank/credit card company to let them know you're traveling** so charges will not end up declined
- **Take photos the front and back of credit cards** or write the number down to call in case of loss.
- **Arrange for pet care** and for your **mail & newspapers** to be picked up or held. **Turn off water, remove** perishables from refrigerator, **take out trash, lock doors, water houseplants**

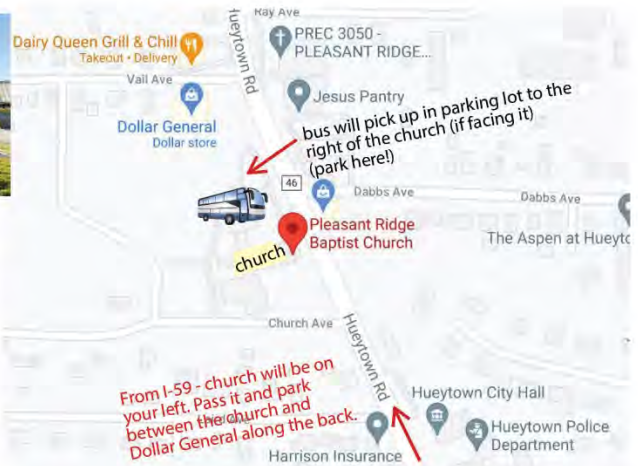
TIPPING: Tips for the motorcoach driver and location tour guides were included in your trip cost.

The tip for your Travel Agent/Group Leader was **not** included. Customary tipping is \$2 per person per day (\$14 per person) if you feel that you have received excellent service during the trip.

WiFi: We cannot guarantee the motorcoach will have WiFi. Please be prepared to use your phone data. We will pass through areas with weak cell phone signals as well. Make any necessary calls while we are in areas with a strong signal. If WiFi is available, it is not for streaming video. If you plan to watch movies on your phone/ipad please download them directly to your device prior to leaving home.

Personal Luggage Tags: Attach personal luggage tags with your name, address and cell phone number to each piece of luggage.

Diamond Luggage Tags: in addition to your personal tags, place the paper Diamond tags you received in the mail on your luggage. One tag is for your smaller OVERNIGHT suitcase. The other is for your larger suitcase. * don't forget these and make sure the correct tag is on each suitcase.

No Carry-on Bags with open tops or items stuffed into plastic bags (like Walmart bags)




Drinks / Snacks on Bus:



● **Only** drink bottles with **screw on caps** or **leak-proof screw-on tops!**

● **Water Bottles:** One ice chest will be under the bus with water bottles. (we accept small donations to help buy water and ice along the way)

● **Shareable Snacks:** if you bring homeade snacks, please individually wrap them or put in snack baggies. Pre-packaged items are fine as is. (ex. chips, crackers, etc.) (35 people)

● **NO orange snacks** like cheese puffs, cheese curls, etc.  (it can stain the bus seats)



Larger Suitcase
(1 per person)

● This larger luggage will be placed under the motorcoach first and **you will NOT have access to it until night 2** when we reach our hotel in Homestead FL Fairfield Inn & Suites

● This luggage will be taken to your hotel room by the hotel staff. *(you can carry it in if you prefer)*

● You will leave your **larger luggage outside** of your hotel room door by 7:15am on the morning of Jan 26th to be picked up by hotel staff.



Smaller Suitcase
(1 per person)

● This luggage will be used in the **en-route hotel**.

● You will have **access to this suitcase on nights 1 and 6** in our Valdosta, GA Wingate Hotel.

YOU will carry this luggage to and from your hotel room, so use a rolling suitcase that you can easily handle.



Examples of Carry-On Bag Types
Approx. Size:
9" x 10" x 19"

1 Per Person

Carry-On Bag (must fit under seat or in overhead bin)
(1 per person) **(bag must latch or zip closed)**

Use Provided Tag + Personal Tag

- face mask (in case somewhere requires them)
- personal papers/documents/insurance cards
- photo identification, credit cards and money
- travel pillow, blanket, eye mask, ear plugs
- prescription medications
- medicine: allergy, sleep aid, digestion, diarrhea, constipation, motion sickness, vitamins, etc.
- cell phone
- camera, binoculars
- ipdad/ tablet /kindle
- chargers-for phone, tablet, camera, CPAP, etc.
- headphones / earbuds
- glasses, reading glasses, sunglasses
- contact lenses & solution
- sun hat or other hat
- makeup, toiletries, sunscreen
- rain poncho / travel size umbrella
- hand sanitizer, small tissue packets
- small personal battery powered fan
- light jacket
- **NOTE:** CPAP Machine and equipment can be in its own separate carry-on bag but still needs to fit under your seat.
